We are about \$100 short in scholarship requests but we received money from parents who donated money specifically to be used for scholarships so that will put that line back in the black.

\$2900 were the profits the kids were able to use in Butter Braid profits.

The kids will need to be responsible for their own costs. Last year the cost was \$2200. Hot Java should yield \$10000. \$1625-extra chaperone costs. Rough estimate would be about \$1500 per kid. Dates for the trip will be Tuesday, May 3 – Sunday, May 8. We need 9 rooms total. We could cover the complete cost for Matt & Danny, \$300 for each of the chaperones (Robin, Kelly Smith & Kelly Eisenhour). We could raise some money at the ASB auction and the kids are encouraged to find fundraising opportunities.
