Treasurer report: Sue went over balance in account. Still have some money but will go for French Horns. Still have money in student reserves and teachers fund. Received the check from the Snoqualmie Tribe to go to Mid-west trip, money from band camp and miscellaneous donations. Also received photo money. Safeway check to come to school for band boosters. *Bill will get it to us. Net band camp was around \$4000 net gain.

Expenses paid out: directors for band camp, yearly fee to WMEA and will collect from choir, purchased gear for marching camp, paid for food and yearly reservation fees through district. And paid a down payment for French horns.

Uniforms: next year ASB will collect and pay for cleaning. Details being worked out on when and how they get cleaned and paid. We will pay for cleaning this year since we collected for it already.

Budget to be presented at parent meeting. Changed the name of Disney trip to spring trip and added \$2000 for uniform purchase.

Matt asked about monies for Ellington. Sue explained that it was all done before the end of the fiscal year. *Matt to follow up with Sue about getting money from district/Belcher for Ellington.

We went over potential questions that parents may ask at meeting about the budget.

Directors Report: Matt and Bill are working on MidWest and Spring trip or mid winter break. Will send out an email that will have a commitment form so we know how many will go, what dates and cost. Bill checking on travel companies. Dinner regardless of game being cancelled on Friday due to weather.

Presidents' Report: Butter Braids - Lorraine researched and found out that we can make a portion of the sales benefit the entire band and the other portion can go to an individual account. We should be more specific about what funds are used for, that way it is very clear what the monies benefit. Maria asked if this will affect where we pull from scholarship – Lorraine does not think so. More will go to the general fund if we specify an amount and not a percentage. We need to kick off on Oct 9th with returned orders on Oct 23rd.

Snap Raise – February 6th – March 4th. Uniform fittings on September 19th. Band Photos – Bob would like to do a few poses rather than one which would take more than one day. Matt does not want to give up two days of class time. Would it be worthwhile to have Bob come in and sit down with us to talk about how this will work – Matt says no. Maybe a photo booth before and after concert that Bob provides.
